## Systemd mounts network drive before activating networking

When using iSCSI, SMB, NFS, ... it is possible that it is trying to mount it before the network is activated. Obviously this will not work. Luckily there is a fix for this, in the /etc/fstab file you can add \_netdev as an option to mount it after the networking has started. For example:

<NETWORK\_DRIVE> /mnt/drive2 ext4 defaults,\_netdev 0 0
